**TOUR REGISTRATION DEADLINES:**

Victoria BC Day Trip, Orca Whale Cruise, Lunch at Tillicum Village, Canadian Loop Tour: **JUNE 15, 2005**  
(Any registrations that arrive after the above date will be registered on a case-by-case basis, based on availability.)

**TOUR TICKETS:**

You must pick up your advance purchased tickets at the Seattle Hospitality Services Tour Registration Desk near the Conference Registration area located at the Convention Center. The Tour Desk will be open on Sunday, July 24<sup>th</sup> to Wednesday, July 27<sup>th</sup> (look for posted hours upon arrival). You may also purchase additional tickets on-site at the registration desk based on availability. **There will be an additional \$3.00 fee for tickets purchased after deadline or for on-site ticket sales.**

**TOUR DEPARTURES:**

You are responsible for arranging your own transportation to the Post Conference Tour departure locations. The Victoria BC Day Trip, Orca Whale Cruise and Canadian Loop Tour all depart from Pier 69 which is a short 5 minute cab ride. The Tillicum Village Lunch departs from Pier 55/56 which is also a short 5 minute cab ride. You must check in at the dock 45 minutes prior to departure to collect your boarding passes.

**CANCELLATIONS:**

Prepaid tour registrations are refundable **only** if canceled by the above listed deadline dates. (There will be no refunds or exchanges after the deadline cutoff.)

**\*CANADIAN TOUR RESTRICTIONS** (applies to the Victoria Day Trip and the Canadian Loop Tours)

When traveling between Canada and the United States, it will be necessary to pass through Customs at the border. Identification is necessary for Customs and Immigration. Due to heightened security at the United States/Canadian border crossing, it is strongly recommended that all travelers travel with a passport. If you are a United States or Canadian born citizen, a valid driver's license is often sufficient. When traveling aboard the Victoria Clipper without a passport, it is recommended that you also bring an original or certified copy of a birth certificate and photo ID. Other carriers may require a passport. Remember, it is the traveler's responsibility to prove his/her citizenship. If you are not a United States or Canadian born citizen, you will be required to have a passport and possibly a Visa.

Parents traveling with children and infants are required to provide identification and proof of citizenship for each child. If both parents are not present, the traveling parent must provide a signed statement from the other parent allowing the child to travel out of the country. Failure to provide such evidence may make you unable to cross the border with your children.

Persons with a felony may be denied entrance into Canada. If you have been convicted of a crime in the United States it may be considered a felony in Canada. A Driving While Intoxicated conviction (D.W.I.) is considered a felony in Canada.
