<b>Reasons for Attending or not</b>	My primary DICOM responsibility is as chair of
Attending	WG28 (physics). This leads to leading the effort
	for the WG on various change proposals and
	supplements which are circulated to other WGs
	(particularly WG06 and WG21 this year). I attend
	those meetings to discuss those work items and
	then bring that feedback back to WG02/28.

	interpretation of RDSRs. This has led to
	several new CPs to clean up the existing
	standard for consistency in dose reporting
	structures. This work is ongoing and is
	expected to continue through 2025 due to
	the length of the supplement.
	- WG02/28 is also extending the protocol storage objects from CT and XA to
	DX/RF/MG. This will create a framework
	to transfer both defined and performed
	protocol storage objects to better relay the
	technical parameters accompanying the
	image data. Again, this is ongoing work and
	expected to continue through 2025.
<b>General Description of</b>	DICOM is organized into WGs based on typical
Activities of the	work items and topics. This may be by modality

Meeting:	outreach, teaching). Work items approved by the
	DICOM Standards Committee (DSC) are assigned
	to WGs to complete and this effort may involve
	input or feedback from other WGs. Membership is
	a mix of both users and manufacturers, creating
	good relationships and understandings for the
	DICOM framework. AAPM's representation at
	these meetings is critical for both the successful
	and reasonable implementation of the DICOM
	standard and so the AAPM members has a

Issues for AAPM:	AAPM has several members volunteering for the most active DICOM WGs. These members are passionate and volunteer significant time.  Maintaining this group of volunteers (and potentially expanding it) is vital for the continued success of having a seat at the DICOM table.  DICOM 4 was another big item this year and raised the potential for an entirely new version of the standard which may have abandoned the
	backward compatibility of DICOM 3 (the current standard, in place since the early 1990s). Ultimately, DICOM 4 was dropped, with recognition that new parts of the standard (e.g., DICOMweb) may already fill some of the typically cited shortcomings.
	Lastly, there is a potential for DICOM to be moving from NEMA to Advamed following the departure from NEMA of several major manufacturers. There are current discussions of ownership over DICOM and ultimately the AAPM representatives (3 total) will have the ability to vote on this when it likely comes up in 2025.
<b>Budget Request (\$):</b>	Continued support for AAPM representation on DICOM WGs through DICOMC budgeting process. Some groups have moved to more virtual meetings, though in person, multi-day meetings are still planned for other groups.
